

Digital Learning Policy St Aloysius' College

Technology is seen as one tool which can significantly enhance deep learning by making possible more individualised learning for each pupil. By putting powerful tools in the hands of the pupils, we hope to enable transformational change in learning within the College.

All pupils from P7 to S2 are expected to have an iPad with them every day. S3 pupils (the original pilot year) can also use other devices such as netbooks or Macbooks but must have a device. The devices should have enough charge to last the school day. To connect to the school Wi-Fi, pupils must install Meraki Systems Manager profiles. This restricts them to age appropriate apps and content.

Pupils in S4 to S6 are allowed to use a personal device such as a tablet or laptop as they see fit. They can login to the school Wi-Fi.

Pupils are expected to have access to a word processor and presentation software. For the iPad Pages and Keynote are the school standard. Pupils using other packages will need to provide assignments in a format that can be opened by teachers.
