

## Pupil Digital Learning Policy St Aloysius' College

Technology is seen as one tool which can significantly enhance deep learning through making possible more individualised learning for each pupil. By putting powerful tools in the hands of the pupils, we hope to enable transformational change in learning within the College.

All pupils from P7 to S4 are expected to have an iPad with them every day. The devices should have enough charge to last the school day. To connect iPads to the school Wi-Fi, pupils must install Meraki Systems Manager profiles. This restricts them to age appropriate apps and content. Apple Classroom should be used by teachers to monitor the use of iPads in class.

Pupils in S5 and S6 are allowed to use a personal device such as a tablet or laptop as they see fit and with the permission of the class teacher whilst continuing to comply with the other relevant polices. They should login to the school Wi-Fi.

Pupils are expected to have access to a word processor and presentation app. There are many such apps available with Word, Pages, PowerPoint and Keynote being the most common. Pupils using other packages will need to provide assignments in a format that can be opened by teachers.
